

Parent/Student Information Sheet:

During your trip to Dagmar Resort, all students are required to participate in a ski or snowboard lesson. Our Snow School will evaluate the student's skiing or boarding abilities and place them in the appropriate class. At the end of each lesson, each student's ticket is marked to indicate which runs are available for their usage. If at any time, they are not able to perform controlled skiing/boarding they will be asked to return to the magic carpet area to practice their skills.

Students should be advised to wear the following:

- 1 pair of socks (extra socks are advisable), only one pair to be worn in the boots.
- □ 1 pair of long underwear.
- □ 1 pair of ski pants the cuffs are not to be tucked inside the boot.
- □ 1 undershirt.
- □ 1 long sleeved turtleneck.
- □ 1 sweater or fleece pullover.
- □ 1 winter jacket.
- □ 1hat.
- □ 1 pair of waterproof "warm" gloves or mittens.

 Please note that knitted gloves or mittens are unsuitable for skiing or boarding.
- Goggles are optional but certainly advisable for those cold or snowy days.
- □ Sunglasses are optional but certainly advisable for those bright sunny days!

No scarves or any dangly apparel will be permitted on the slopes!

Please be sure to inform us in writing of any food, medical allergies and/or conditions.
